Sex Offender Information Bulletin

January 6, 2025

The Dane County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.46(2m) which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's relocation when, in the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety, awareness and protection. The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense. He is NOT wanted by the police at this time.

This notification is not intended to increase fear; rather, it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. Sex offenders have always lived in our communities; but it was not until Act 440 was enacted that law enforcement was able to share this information with the community. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated.

In 1988, Phillips was convicted of First Degree Sexual Assault. Phillips is a lifetime registrant of the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registration Program. Phillips is scheduled to relocate to 1821 USH 12 / 18 in the Town of Cottage Grove in early January, 2025. Phillips will be supervised by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services.
